



Field Mission Report: Sud, Grande Anse & Nippes 9.5.21

Key Findings:

- Assessment & Security Update:
 - Multiple roadblocks this morning (9.6.21) in greater PAP @6:50 am: Carrefour DROUILLARD is still blocked with 2 trucks preventing vehicles from getting through, use alternate routes; Cité Militaire, Villaj, Simon/Pele areas along Airport Rd there are some road blockages and sustained shooting being heard; avoid these areas, use alternate routes, and maintain awareness for security concerns.
 - Ongoing coordination to outlying regions in both Grand Anse, Nippes, and Sud Departments.
 - Coordination with HaitiOne partners and the LOG clusters to identify secure routes into unserved and underserved communities.
 - Moving to regional coordination alongside HaitiOne regional partners for coordination meetings on health, logs, education, food items, and NFIs.
- Distribution Update:
 - Ongoing coordination with HaitiOne partners, local government, and the DPC in Grand Anse and Sud Departments to prioritize distributions and conduct assessments to serve those in greatest need.
 - The HaitiOne team is continuing to maintain a 24-hour turnaround on field assessment needs and distribution in coordination with DPC and local leadership (Mayors & Pastors).
- Update to Response Capabilities:
 - 3 primary beachheads for distribution in the affected region:
 - Les Anglais: J635 Ministries, southwest coast
 - Les Cayes: RMI, Sud Dept
 - Jeremie: HBM & Fondation Dauphin, Grand Anse Dept
- Med Support Brief:
 - Please see and review published distribution plan and needs for refreshed needs from major healthcare facilities in the affected regions.
 - Active coordination with Direct Relief Intl to support critical needs to 7 healthcare facilities in the Grand Anse and Sud Departments.
 - Ongoing movement and coordination with Jack Brewer Fndn and Haitian physicians to mobilize personnel support to healthcare facilities, and to expand their region of primary care through mobile medical clinics.

9.5.21 - Field Objectives Met:

- Ongoing prioritization and coordination for daily distributions.
- Confirm team lodging and transportation for medical support and construction personnel.



- Confirm mid-term storage and logistics plans.
- Continue re-supply efforts across all departments.

Next Steps & Objectives for September 6, 2021

- Refresh field teams with additional support staff to continue aggressive pace of support via assessments and distribution mgmt alongside regional HaitiOne partners.
- Support and reinforce regional partners in regional coordination with DPC, IOM, OCHA and UNDAC as response localizes through regional partners.
- MOH will continue to support via relief items, assessments, and distribution support as needs and requests continue.
- Evaluate and confirm prioritization for school reconstruction, medical reinforcement, and community re-development through housing security and church support initiatives.
