



Field Mission Report: Sud, Grande Anse & Nippes 9.6.21

Key Findings:

- Assessment & Security Update:
 - Daily LOGs updates to HaitiOne Critical Comms (WhatsApp) thread for live updates on blokis, road closures, and other transportation adjustments.
 - Ie. Multiple roadblocks 9.6.21 in greater PAP @6:50 am: Carrefour DROUILLARD is still blocked with 2 trucks preventing vehicles from getting through, use alternate routes; Cité Militaire, Villaj, Simon/Pele areas along Airport Rd there are some road blockages and sustained shooting being heard; avoid these areas, use alternate routes, and maintain awareness for security concerns.
 - Moving to regional coordination alongside HaitiOne regional partners for coordination meetings on health, logs, education, food items, and NFIs.
- Distribution Update:
 - 5 communities with 460 families served with 345 food kits (3-week rations) and 70 shelter kits families served in the Grand Anse, Nippes and Sud Departments.
 - 8 communities and 1580 families in the Grand Anse, Nippes and Sud Departments added to the HaitiOne distribution plan for 9.7.21.
 - Ongoing coordination with HaitiOne partners, local government, and the DPC in Grand Anse and Sud Departments to prioritize distributions and conduct assessments to serve those in greatest need.
 - The HaitiOne team is continuing to maintain a 24-hour turnaround on field assessment needs and distribution in coordination with DPC and local leadership (Mayors & Pastors).
- Update to Response Capabilities:
 - Received supply reinforcement with arrival of 2 FOME trucks.
 - 3 primary beachheads for distribution in the affected region:
 - Les Anglais: J635 Ministries, southwest coast
 - Les Cayes: RMI, Sud Dept
 - Jeremie: HBM & Fondation Dauphin, Grand Anse Dept
- Med Support Brief:
 - The Les Anglais medical facility had its first baby delivered in the new maternity ward extension which was set up at the request of the medical director, donated from USAID, and distributed through the regional HaitiOne Partner J635 to meet the need of this community.
 - Please see and review published distribution plan and needs for refreshed list of urgent equipment, supply, and personnel shortages from major healthcare facilities in the affected regions.
 - Active coordination with Direct Relief Intl to support critical needs to 7 healthcare facilities in the Grand Anse and Sud Departments.



- Ongoing movement and coordination with Jack Brewer Fndn and Haitian physicians to mobilize personnel support to healthcare facilities, and to expand their region of primary care through mobile medical clinics.

9.6.21 - Field Objectives Met:

- Confirmed setup of new medical extension (maternity ward) at Les Anglais health center.
- Supply support via Dr. Marlene to medical facilities in Grand Anse and Sud departments.
- Refresh field teams with additional support staff to continue aggressive pace of support via assessments and distribution mgmt alongside regional HaitiOne partners.
- Support and reinforce regional partners in regional coordination with DPC, IOM, OCHA and UNDAC as response localizes through regional partners.
- Evaluate and confirm prioritization for school reconstruction, medical reinforcement, and community re-development through housing security and church support initiatives.

Next Steps & Objectives for September 7, 2021

- Secure medical supplies and personnel support for medical care facilities in the affected region.
- 8 distributions set up from regional HaitiOne partners.
- Ongoing assessments of under-served and unserved areas.
- Refreshed prioritization of school support needs via temporary structure and long-term structure.
- Renewed assessments of road blocks as security concerns intensify.
