


HAITI AND THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC

At the end of a recent training session with pastors, two of our staff members stood in the back of the room and witnessed a moment take place between two pastors. David, a Haitian pastor, approached Jose, a Dominican pastor, who was quietly sitting at the back of the room. Pastor David walked up to Pastor Jose and invited him to speak at his church.

This was not just a regular invitation between two pastors. This was a cross-cultural invitation. While the news is filled with headlines of the tensions between the countries of Haiti and the Dominican Republic, this was a reminder that God writes a different story—a better story.

This invitation was a testament to the years of sewing seeds in ministry, intentionally bringing together pastors, churches, and leaders and displaying a Gospel-centered unity that transcends countries, races, socioeconomic status, and borders.

Farmer Training What makes this story even more extraordinary is the response it elicited. Without hesitation, Pastor Jose's wife, Mrs. Cristal, answered with a resounding "Yes!" Pastor Jose smiled earto-ear, nodding his head in agreement with his wife. Their response beautifully displayed the heart of oneness between two differing countries with a shared unity in Jesus. The passage in Ephesians 2:14-18 discusses how Christ came to break down the dividing wall of hostility, reconciling the Jews and the Gentiles. Thousands of years later, Christ is doing the same thing between cultures.

In a world where political tensions often dominate headlines and divide nations. the harmony and unity being fostered within these churches are a living testament to God's work here. It is a tangible reminder that, despite external differences and conflicts, God is working through His church.

When you partner with Mission of Hope, your support enables us to continue empowering pastors like Jose and David. facilitating transformative training programs, and fostering the kind of unity that transcends borders and brings communities together.

NUTRITION

The hunger crisis in Haiti has grown dire in recent years due to compounding issues, including economic instability, gang control, and natural disasters. The quality nutrition we are able to provide is quite literally the only meal many children receive for the day. Good nutrition is the foundation for healthy bodies and minds. By providing access to a continuum of resources from education to meals to sustainability, Mission of Hope is committed to meeting this basic need and combating malnutrition and starvation.



FUEL FOR DREAMS

Recent reports from 2023 indicate that a staggering 8 million people in Haiti are currently facing food insecurity, accounting for over 75% of the nation's population. Mission of Hope has been tirelessly working to combat this crisis through nutrition partnerships and a reliable distribution network, ensuring that food reaches those in dire need.

This is Géliamise, she is a mom and grandma in Haiti. Tragically, her grandson was left with her when he was just a baby, and she's raised him since the day he was left with her years ago. After raising three children of her own, now having the added responsibility of caring for another child was one she wasn't expecting, but she sacrificially stepped in to care for him. Her grandson attends a school in the Mission of Hope network,

so he receives a nutritious meal every day at school. She said she is so thankful for school because her grandson is developing into the man he is destined to be. Géliamise shared, **"When the children have received balanced meals, they are happy and have the strength to play."**

Flore-Anne Jean, also known as Madame Flore, is the Mission of Hope Education Superintendent in Haiti. She is full of passion, drive, and commitment to seeing children in her country have the opportunity to receive a quality, Christ-centered education. Madame Flore also works closely with our Women's Empowerment team in Haiti. Every time we talk with her, she shares another story about the impact the ministry has on young girls, moms, and women in Haiti. This past year, Madame Flore and her team worked tirelessly to provide education for students. From navigating security issues to hand delivering school assignments to figuring out communication to rural schools in the mountains—they refuse to give up because they know the future leaders of Haiti are in these classrooms.

Enjoy learning more about Madame Flore's story:

It took me seven years of study at university to get where I am today—an Education Superintendent. I completed secondary school in my hometown at Camp-Perrin, and it was hard to leave my family, my brother, and my sister, to come to Port-au-Prince for university since I had never been away from home before. I had some financial obstacles. especially when getting my Master's Degree in Education, but I worked very hard and used almost all of my salary just to pay for my schooling. The hardest part of my job is when our team works to have a plan for the school year, but then a political or health situation ruins the plan! The best part of my job is contributing to the education of the children of my country.



MEDICAL CARE

By meeting the medical needs of those who are sick, people experience relief and hope in the midst of their pain. Physical healing often opens the door for spiritual conversations and is vital to the holistic life transformation taking place at Mission of Hope.



MOBILE MEDICAL CLINICS DOMINICAN REPUBLIC

In the Dominican Republic, many Haitians are terrified to go to a local hospital for fear of how they'll be treated. The mobile medical clinics Mission of Hope is able to facilitate are the only medical care many people have received in several years. These clinics have provided local pastors a way to invite the hurting in their communities to see their needs tangibly met, while also opening up faith conversations and the opportunity to pray with members of their community. Many children in under-served areas, both Haitian and Dominican, have never seen a doctor or dentist before they were seen at a mobile medical clinic.

An integral part of medical care at Mission of Hope is partnering with medical professionals from around the world who serve on HopeGo mission trips and use their gifts to serve others.

DISASTER RESPONSE

Mission of Hope has been one of the first to step in and meet needs during times of disaster, from earthquakes, hurricane, flooding, and the long-term damage these disasters cause for the most vulnerable. Our partner network makes for efficient and effective distribution, alongside the local church, to get critical aid to those who need it most.



HIGUEY DOMINICAN REPUBLIC

When a hurricane hit the Dominican Republic and caused widespread damage on the eastern side of the island, Mission of Hope responded quickly and, through rapid assessments, determined hundreds of families in the community of Higuey were in need of aid to help them rebuild during that difficult time. In coordination with the local government, local churches, pastors, businesses, and organizations, Mission of Hope distributed food, hygiene kits, tarps, and clothing donations to those who were hit hardest and in the most vulnerable situations.





Right now the most critical need in Haiti is food. Due to rising inflation, political instability, and the devaluation of the Haitian gourde, **Almost half of the population in Haiti is in a food insecurity crisis.** Now food is more expensive, and their money is worth less. One mother told us it feels like her bread is shrinking.

Although we serve over 125,000 meals to students in our nutrition program every day, there are over **80,000 kids on our waiting list at the start of 2024** who are also in desperate need.

We believe the current reality in Haiti doesn't have to be this way.


It only costs about \$10/month to provide one hot, nutritious meal every day.

MEAL PACKING

We partner with businesses, churches, and schools around North America to organize and host meal packing events so that we can provide food for children at nearly 500 schools and orphanages across Haiti.

When you fill a gym, church hall, or sports arena with busy tables, the output is jaw-dropping and life-saving. Every meal pack event is a lively, community-building experience. As a volunteer, you'll work side-by-side with friends, family, coworkers, or other like-minded people to package meals. We welcome volunteers of all ages and backgrounds.



Mission of Hope partners with several meal packing organizations. These organizations procure the bulk food, transport food to your event, provide all packing equipment, and secure shipping to Haiti. In most situations, the host is responsible to raise funds, recruit volunteers, reserve event location, and provide tables and extension cords.
