



Regarding the Assassination of Haitian President Jovenel Moise this morning (7.7.21):

Please receive this request on behalf of the Haitian people, the communities we serve daily across Haiti, and the Haitian diaspora who are praying for Haiti and mourning today.

- The assassination of President Moise threatens to usher in heightened lawlessness, as gangs have already been running much of Port au Prince. Local actors operate daily under threat of violence. We have great concerns regarding the stability to continue vital services.
- The assassination of a democratically elected head of state requires an international investigation, especially amidst growing concerns of international interference by alleged commandos posing as U.S. DEA officials. We request international accountability on behalf of the Haitian people.
- We recommend all international coordination respect Haitian sovereignty, with international support working through the Haitian Prime Minister to ensure peacekeeping operations in PAP operate under the authority of the Haitian Government, working in concert to secure the state until a democratically elected official is re-installed as head of state.

In the interest of honoring the will of the Haitian people, we request an emergency UN Security Council meeting resulting in an urgent plan of action for...

1. Investigation into the assassination of President Jovenel Moise by alleged international actors;
2. Intervention to stabilize and support the Haitian Government amidst instability and rampant gang violence;
3. Protection of popular sovereignty for Haiti and facilitation of peaceful elections until the reinstatement of a democratically elected head of state.
